Fund Established to Aid George Toman

In response to numerous requests by several BCOB members, the Church Council has approved the establishment of a special fund to receive monies to help George Toman (and his daughter Stephanie) in the aftermath of a moped accident in which George was seriously injured. George has been hospitalized at MUSC for over a week, has had extensive leg surgery to repair a shattered femur, and is awaiting further surgery to repair facial fractures.

Prior to the accident, George's hours working at the golf course at Parris Island had been cut to 25 hrs./week, and his wife Cheryl is disabled and confined to Bay View Nursing Home as a result of Huntington's Disease. His recovery will be long and this special fund will provide critically needed help during this time.
